

Rehoboth Life Care Ministries Dental Clinic

The clinic primarily operates on the donations from our local churches and individuals in our community. As with any business, we have a wide range of needs. If you and your church members are looking for items that we can give directly to the patients, any oral hygiene products would be appreciated. Also, at times we have patients that cannot afford their prescriptions or even over-the-counter pain medication that they need after dental procedures, so (small denomination) gift cards to a pharmacy (\$5 or \$10) would help. Also, very small bottles (or sample size) of over-the-counter sealed ibuprofen, aspirin or naproxen sodium could be distributed to those in need. Some of our patients have transportation issues. Small denomination value of gift cards to a gas station would help those patients.

We can always use paper products such as toilet tissue, Kleenex, paper towels, copy paper, Post-It-notes, postage stamps, 13 gallon and 33 gallon trash bags and any cleaning or laundry product and hand sanitizer and liquid hand soap.

Whatever you and your church members decide to do for the clinic will be greatly appreciated, not only by us at the clinic, but also by the patients. All of our patients have been screened and are found to be at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level, as well as they are not covered by any type of dental insurance. Our patients are truly in need of any help we are able to provide for them. Please pray for our patients and our staff/volunteers that God's will be done in this clinic for His glory.
